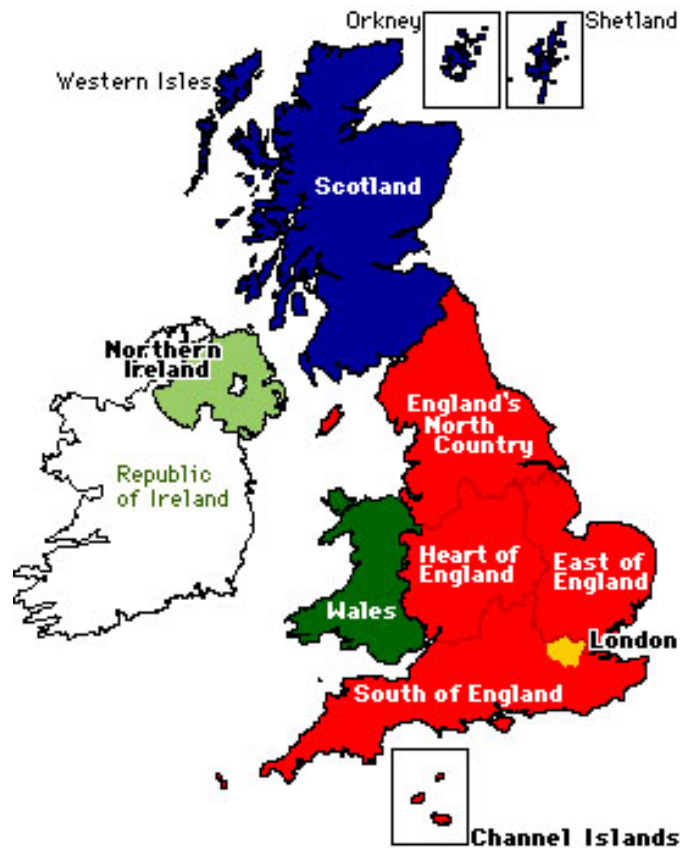

REGISTRATION CONDITIONS:

Registration and payment terms:

A registration will be considered binding on both parties upon receipt of a Player Registration Form and a deposit of \$300 for each traveler. In accepting your registration, *Challenger World Tours* a division of the *Challenger Sports Corporation* agrees to carry out obligations to you as listed in our specific itinerary supplied to your group. All travelers are requested to follow the payment plan provided. Tour bookings and flights cannot be guaranteed without adhering to the payment schedule.

Free Places:

A free place is offered to the traveling group for every 15 paying travelers. This place is usually reserved for the coach or team administrator although it can be used for any chosen traveler. In return for this free trip this chosen traveler will be responsible for helping to collect all materials and team information to assist in team sign up and team administration.

Exchange rates:

All costs are calculated in the respective exchange rates when providing an initial group tour cost. Challenger Sports reserves the right to adjust final fees if there is an increase in the exchange rate. If this applies, any increase or decrease will be calculated at the paying of the final balance.

Flights:

If you decide to use the Challenger World Tour flight option then you will need to acknowledge this on the group booking form enclosed. If booking your own flight you will need to correspond with Challenger World Tours regarding your flight details. If traveling separate from the main group, please be aware you will be responsible for all transportation costs until you meet up with the main tour group in the UK.

Travel Insurance:

Tour price includes (per person): travel medical coverage up to \$25,000; emergency medical transport up to \$250,000; flight accident insurance up to \$100,000; travel delay up to \$600; baggage loss up to \$1000; baggage delay up to \$200; trip cancellation & interruption up to \$500. Trip cancellation due to a pre-existing condition is excluded unless the entire trip cost is insured. To upgrade to full trip-cost coverage call World Travel Center toll free at 1-800-234-1862 within 14 days after you have paid your initial trip deposit and mention the Challenger Sports Group."

Traveling supporters, parents or siblings:

Traveling supporters, parents or siblings are more than welcome to join the tour group for the whole tour or special arrangements can be made for them to join for a portion of the scheduled itinerary, if they so wish. All ground transportation, accommodation and food packages will be the same as the main group unless special requirements with Challenger World Tours are made in advance. A registration form along with a \$300 deposit will be required for each traveling supporter.

Group Size:

All tours pricing is based on a minimum of 25 travelers. If the group size falls below this number the group may be subject to an additional charge to cover transportation fees. This additional fee will be waived if the group can be combined with another traveling party.

Single Room Requests:

All travelers will be placed in a double, twin or triple room when staying in hotels during the tour. Adults may request a single room at an additional charge. All special rooming requests must be received 90 days, prior to departure.

Itinerary Information:

The itinerary that has been provided to you previously is a sample itinerary, which is subject to modification and change. The final detailed itinerary will be mailed to you or a Challenger Tour group leader for your team no later than two weeks prior to your departure along with phone numbers and addresses of all accommodations and contact persons to your destinations.

Inclement Weather:

In the event of a sporting event or fixture being deemed unplayable due to weather conditions, every attempt will be made to reschedule the game(s) at a later date in the tour. Challenger World Tours cannot be held responsible for the cancellation of games within a tournament organized by a third party. In this case, rescheduling and/or refunds will be at the discretion of the tournament organizer.

Passports and Visa's:

Passports are required for all Challenger World Tour programs so apply at least 10 weeks before departure (sooner if you need a visa). Contact your local post office for the forms. For further information, visit the web site at www.travel.state.gov. Visas (if applicable) will need to be applied for at least 16 weeks before departure. Non-U.S. citizens are responsible for obtaining all documents needed to enter the countries to be visited or connected through and for re-entry into the U.S.A. Please consult the consular offices of the countries on your itinerary, as well as the U.S. immigration office, for complete details.

Luggage:

Due to airline restrictions the limit is 44lbs per person, which includes one suitcase and one small carry on item.

Waivers:

Challenger World Tours reserves the right to make changes in fees, departure dates, departure cities, itinerary, airlines, hotels, field trips and activities. Such changes are not grounds for withdrawal from or cancellation with refund. Challenger World Tours may cancel a program due to insufficient enrollment, unforeseen operational difficulties, lack of projected availability or any other reasons. If a trip is cancelled by Challenger World Tours, a full refund will be made within 45 days except when a Tour is cancelled by conditions outside Challenger World Tours control, in which case all payments excluding the initial deposit will be refunded. Future Challenger World Tours advertising and publicity material may include statements made by participants or their photographs, and it is agreed that consent is given to such use of comments or photographic likenesses.

Cancellation Policy:

All cancellations must be done in writing and mailed by recorded delivery to Challenger World Tours, 6855 Jimmy Carter Boulevard, Suite 2420, Norcross, Georgia 30071 USA. Cancellations received prior to March 1st 2004 will result in a \$300 per traveler penalty. Cancellations between March 1st and April 15th will result in a \$750 per traveler penalty and cancellations after April 15th will result in no refund.

CONDUCT RULES AND REGULATIONS

Challenger World Tours are proud of the fact that they have not experienced any major disciplinary problems during past tours.

The following is a list of rules and expectations and various consequences:

1. Any use or possession of alcoholic beverages is strictly prohibited and will result in your expulsion from the tour. The families concerned will pay for the cost of early flights back to the United States.
2. Vandalism or stealing will result in expulsion from the tour.
3. Players must be in groups of four or more when in shopping areas, swimming pools, sightseeing areas and during official tour functions.
4. Curfew for players will be at 10:30pm. This may be extended or shortened at the discretion of the coach or Challenger World Tours staff member.
5. Unlawful acts by any player will result in immediate expulsion from the tour and appropriate punishment by civil authorities concerned.
6. Lack of respect for the coaching staff and/or administrators may result in loss of privileges, i.e. absence from team games and functions.
7. Unauthorized absence(s) from games, practices or excursions may result in tour termination.
8. No player traveling alone will be allowed to undertake any body piercing or tattoos.

It is understood that should a player be expelled from the tour for disciplinary reasons all expenses will be the responsibility of the player's family. No refunds will be given. Challenger World Tours bears no liability for any costs incurred as a result of expulsion.
